Portage County is located in the midst of northeastern Ohio's urban centers with a population of 161,419. The County has maintained an AA rating from Standard & Poor's.

The County utilizes two primary fund categories: Proprietary and Governmental. Proprietary Funds are self-sufficient, covering all costs associated with providing a specific service for Portage County residents, such as the Solid Waste Recycling Center, Portage County Water, Portage County Sewer, and Streetsboro Sewer.

Governmental Funds encompass a wider range of activities and services. These functions are broken down into eight major categories: *Legislative and Executive* include the costs for the County's administrative offices such as the Auditor, Commissioners, Treasurer, Prosecutor, and Recorder; *Judicial* expenditures refer to the County court system; *Public Safety* operations include the Sheriff, Emergency Management, and Probation departments; *Public Works* expenditures relate to maintaining our roads and bridges; *Health* activities are comprised of Development Disabilities, Dog and Kennel, and the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Board; *Human Services* expenditures are the operational costs of Job and Family Services and Veteran Services Commission; *Capital* expenditures are those incurred to build or purchase assets that are expected to last more than two years; *Debt* expenditures are interest and principal payments made for County debt.



The large decrease in Public Works was largely CARES Act funding passed through to area businesses in 2020 now returning to previous levels. Public Safety continues to increase due to additional jail staffing and pandemic related expenditures. Capital Outlay was maintained with only necessary projects undertaken due to the uncertainty of the pandemic.



The pandemic continues to infuse millions into the County's coffers, through the ARPA ACT, but not as much as what the CARES Act contributed in the prior year. Property tax revenue continued with the trend of a gradual increase. The decline in sales tax revenue is due to the expiration of an additional ¼% in early 2021. All other revenue streams remain reasonable steady. The conservative spending of the 18 Elected Officials is to be commended for the County's current fiscal health.



Portage County, Ohio Principal Employers Current Year


