

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS  
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION  
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Franklin Township Trustees Kent, Ohio adopted on November 27, 2018, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of Franklin Township at a Primary Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, May 7, 2019, the question levying a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Franklin Township for purposes of providing fire protection and emergency medical services.

Tax being a replacement tax at a rate not exceeding 3.42 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 34.2 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
