

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF  
THE TEN MILL LIMITATION  
PORTAGE COUNTY CHILDREN SERVICES**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Portage County Commissioners on behalf of the Portage County Department of Job & Family Services adopted on January 14, 2021, there will be submitted to the electors of the County at a Primary/Special Election to be held in the County at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the County for purposes of providing care, placement and treatment of abused, neglected and dependent children.

Tax being an additional tax at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
