

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION
ROOTSTOWN LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of resolutions of the Board of Education of the Rootstown Local School District, Ohio passed on December 17, 2018 and January 14, 2019, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of the Rootstown Local School District at the Primary Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, May 7, 2019, the question levying a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Rootstown Local School District for the purpose of general permanent improvements.

Tax being a renewal of an existing tax of 2.5 mills at a rate not exceeding 2.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 25 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

The polls for said election will be open at 6:30 a.m., and will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
