PORTAGE COUNTY ENGINEER COVID 19 OPERATIONS UPDATE

UPDATE 5/28/21: We have re-evaluated the current health conditions during this pandemic and in response to changing federal guidelines and state regulations, made the following decisions regarding the operation of our Department effective 6/1/21:

- 1. The Centers for Disease Control and the Portage County Health District recommend that you get vaccinated against COVID-19 as soon as possible.
- 2. The office and garage remain open to the public. Everyone that is NOT VACCINATED, employees and the public, must wear a mask in order to enter the Building. If you do not have one, we can provide one to you.
- 3. Vaccinated employees may conduct their work mask-free and may discontinue the use of Employee Screening Forms.
- 4. Congregate meetings between unvaccinated employees or with the public should occur with everyone wearing a mask and following proper social distancing within the meeting room.
- 5. All employees who are not vaccinated are to continue performing self-screening daily health assessments at home on the forms provided. You are to continue to turn in a weekly report of health assessments to your Supervisor.
- 6. If you are sick, stay home. Any general illness or signs or symptoms of COVID-19 should be reported "immediately" to your Supervisor.
- 7. We are continuing to advise all employees to regularly wash their hands and disinfect their respective work locations. Vaccinated employees who wish to continue using a face covering for their own additional protection may do so.
- 8. We will re-evaluate and consider additional operational changes when Portage County's conditions warrant or the feds or the Health Department change protocols.
- 9. If you have any operational questions, please contact your Supervisor immediately.
- 10. We will post this Operations Update in conspicuous places around the office, on the bulletin board, and on our website.

I strongly encourage all of you to **get vaccinated.** We need to remain vigilant and continue these safe practices until such time as a majority of us are vaccinated and we achieve herd immunity.
