# COMPREHENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

CCMEP is open to youth ages 14-24 who are in need of case management to overcome barriers to self-sufficiency. Some of these barriers may include things such as homelessness, domestic violence, drug and/or alcohol dependency and basic skills deficiency, just to name a few. Each individual who is enrolled into CCMEP services will be placed with a case manager who will create an Individualized Opportunity Plan (IOP) to help ensure the success of overcoming barriers while promoting educational and employment goals.
