To apply for a WIOA training grant, you must be a resident of Portage County and attend one of the below orientation sessions. Virtual session are available upon request. Please contact Louise at 330-297-3779 for more details. Completed application packets are due within 7 days of the attended orientation. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. Training grants are awarded based off customer applications and appropriateness for training. Not all applicants may be awarded a grant.

Training must:

- Be 12 months or less
- Lead to employment in an in-demand Career
- Result in a recognized certificate or license https://owd.jfs.ohio.gov/wiet/index.xhtml

We are not able to:

- Pay for a degreed program (associates, bachelors, masters, doctoral)
- Assist with training that someone is already enrolled in
- Pay for training in which someone is already credentialed
