**Discussion:** Resolution No. 19-0453 authorized the purchase of one 2020 Freightliner Single Axle Cab and Chassis from Valley Freightliner, Inc. and the resolution before the Board today is for a truck equipment package through Concord Road Equipment Manufacturing Inc. The package includes a dump body, hydraulics, spinner, spreader and the plow. The County Engineer's department purchases 1-2 trucks every year with a 17 year cycle for 20 snowplow routes.

2. Resolution No. 20-0053: The Board of Commissioners declares the necessity to purchase one (1) 2008 GMC 5500 W/42' Verslift SST37EIH-01 Aerial Boom for use by the Portage County Engineer's Department.

**Discussion:** The Engineer's Office has a 1999 boom truck from ODOT that needs to be replaced. A new truck is approximately \$125,000 and the department cannot justify spending that much, but the garage superintendent found a 2008 boom truck in Canton for \$42,000. The life span of a boom truck is at least 15 years with proper maintenance.

# B. Journal Entries:

1. The Board of Commissioners approves the Ohio Department of Transportation 2019 County Highway System Mileage Certification that the total length of Portage County maintained public roads was 368.276 miles as of December 31, 2019, as presented by County Engineer Mickey Marozzi.

**Discussion:** This year's certification is 368.276 miles and at the beginning of Engineer Marozzi's employment, it was 373.00 miles, with the difference being a loss due to annexations. It's important to note the County Engineer's mileage has no bearing on his revenue.

#### REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION

Present: Todd Peetz, Larry Jenkins, County Engineer's Office, Attorney David Garnier, Job and Family Services Director Kellijo Jeffries and Water Resources Department Director Gene Roberts

#### A. Discussion:

1. Scope of Comp Plan

Director Peetz presented a draft scope of services listing all activities that will occur in each sections of the Comp Plan, a timeline, projections and implementation, and costs associated with each, with a price tag of \$50,000.

Portage County is one of the only counties that doesn't have a Comp Plan, but once the plan is put into place, it will provide the big picture for everyone within the County. Director Peetz explained one of his goals is to have interactive Comp Plan maps with touch screens located downstairs to show what's happening within the County over the next 5 years.

Commissioner Kline asked how much time is needed for updates and Director Peetz responded plans should be updated every 5-7 years.

Director Peetz reviewed the potential timeline, which includes a Steering Committee kick off meeting in March, community meeting completion by the end of November, Steering Committee meetings completed in January 2021, and Commissioners' discussions January-April of 2021.

Director Peetz is also interested in doing 'survey monkey' for feedback and wants to attend summertime festivals and fairs for additional community input.

Director Peetz explained separating the County into quadrants because it is so large and he suggested the following:

- Quadrant 1: City of Aurora and Streetsboro, Townships of Mantua and Shalersville
- Quadrant 2: Garrettsville Village, Windham Village, Townships of Hiram, Nelson, Windham, and Freedom.
- Quadrant 3: City of Kent and Ravenna, Townships of Brimfield, Rootstown, Charlestown, Ravenna, and Franklin.
- Quadrant 4: Townships of Paris, Edinburg, Atwater Palmyra and Deerfield.

Commissioner Clyde asked if a  $5^{\text{th}}$  quadrant could be added for Suffield and Randolph and the Board agreed.

Quadrant 5: Townships of Randolph and Suffield.

A Steering Committee will also be necessary and Director Peetz suggests a community representative from the following:

- Quad 1: City of Aurora and Streetsboro, Mantua Village and from either Mantua Township or Shalersville Township total of 4.
- Quad 2 Garrettsville Village and Windham Village, 2 representatives total from Hiram, Nelson, Windham and Freedom Townships total of 4.
- Quad 3 City of Kent and Ravenna, 1 representative from the Townships of Brimfield, Rootstown, Charlestown, Ravenna, or Franklin total of 5.
- Quad 4 Townships of Paris, Edinburg, Atwater, Palmyra and Deerfield total of 3.
- Quad 5 Township of Randolph Suffield total of 1.

Director Peetz pointed out the Steering Committee should be comprised of the following: Portage Development Board, County Engineer's Office, Water Resources Department and possibly the Park District. Additionally, there could be representation from Camp James A. Garfield, Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Kent State University, NEOMED and Hiram College. The Steering Committees should meet in March, May, and July to gather input and a Community Meeting could be scheduled for July, and then future conditions can be done in August, October, December and January. Director Peetz would guide the committee, but a Chairman would need to be selected and possibly a Vice Chairman.

Commissioner Clyde asked about participation by a social services organization and the school districts and Director Peetz noted typically Comp Plans include the schools as part of the capital infrastructure, but it wouldn't hurt to have them included. Commissioner Clyde noted the superintendents meet monthly and one could be the representative and report back to the group. Director Peetz would like to ask high schooler seniors to complete the survey and provide feedback.

Director Peetz also mentioned a subcommittee (staff committee) could be appointed and the document could be put online for multiple agency feedback and still add a school person and a social services person to the Committee.

Feedback for the Scope of Services document: Commissioner Clyde asked about the following:

- How the plan length is decided and Director Peetz indicated typically it's 20-30 years.
- Is this the first plan for Portage County and Director Peetz responded yes.
- The words 'is desirous' should be changed to 'desires' in 2 places.
- Under Scope of Services A. states review the existing community plan and that should be reviewed since Portage County does not have an existing plan.
- Under Scope of Services C. states 'particular attention shall be on the economic development component of the plan' and it might be helpful to highlight other components and Director Peetz explained he will highlight land use, housing, parks, transportation, and public engagement.
- Under the Parks & Recreation section, the committee needs to be mindful about how it interplays with the Park District's plans.
- The Agriculture section should be expanded to include what agriculture does beyond food production.

Director Peetz took note of the comments and will provide the information to the Prosecutor's Office for review.

1. Final draft of MOU for grant writer

Director Peetz presented the revised final language for the proposed grant writer Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

The minor changes to the document include:

- Language for a 3% increase at the discretion of the member partners to decide, if any.
- Language that avoid an annual update.
- A non-profit charge of 150% of actual costs for non-profits that may want to use Regional Planning's time that are not members of the Planning Commission.

Interviews were conducted and 11 people applied, it was narrowed down to 6, 4 were interviewed and 2 were given writing assignments of a 1-2 page executive summary and they both did well.

Commissioner Kline asked if the Building Department pulled out of the program and Director Peetz noted they did, but there's been interest from the Sheriff's Office and Health Department.

Commissioner Clyde noted it's great to have everyone working together and the Board agreed to move forward with the request.

Attorney Garnier noted the County Engineer's last name has been corrected on the document, but his first name should be listed as Michael not Mickey Marozzi and he will make the correction.
