INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

Present: County Auditor Esposito, IT Chief Information Office Lloyd Alger and Budget & Finance Director Todd Bragg

A. Discussion:

- 1. Part-Time IT Specialist
 - Mr. Alger is requesting to hire a part-time IT Specialist at an annual starting wage of \$20.11 for 28 hours per week. This is keeping up with the Clemans Nelson Wage Scale Study that was authorized by the Board of Commissioners in 2018. Mr. Alger indicated that in late 2020, their part-time IT Specialist was promoted to full-time status. This year the money that was previously allocated for the part-time hire was given to the current part-time employee. Mr. Alger indicated that this position is essential to help keep their computer systems repaired and maintained in a timely fashion. Currently, they take the Network Administrator and Systems Administrator away from their primary duties of protecting they network and servers and putting them in the field to handle service calls.
 - Director Alger indicated State mandates were in effect May of 2019; they now audit our office on this type of work. Auditor Esposito said beginning May 2019, at that point the State Auditor's Office audits their work. Mr. Alger indicated they currently have 50 computer systems in the office needing deployment along with a complexly redundant storage system and backup environment. Commissioner Christian–Bennett said last year the Board of Commissioners gave your office \$160,000 to set up the 300 computers. She realizes there were delays due to COVID. What happened to that money? Mr. Alger indicated that money was not spent on contract services. Commissioner Christian–Bennett asked if that money is still available? Mr. Alger said the Auditor's, Treasurer and 2/3 of the Sheriff Department were installed. Director Bragg said there was money available for Dell to install some of them. Mr. Alger said the Clerk of Courts and Muni Court computers are here but not installed. Dell transfers data and installs PC's site for them; we still do software set up. The

difference in cost is approximately \$30 - \$60 each computer. Commissioner Christian-Bennett asked for clarification as to where the \$100,000 was spent. It was spent to move your part-time seasoned employee to full-time and bring the rest of your staff to mid-point. Mr. Alger agreed. County Auditor indicated that the Board has money, and they are not asking for much. The \$160,000 was put in the Internal Services line. Director Bragg said all that money was not used. Commissioner Kline asked what the timeline is to hire for this position. Mr. Lloyd said as soon as possible. He is trying to prioritize the duties at this point. Commissioner Badalamenti asked what the yearly cost would be for this position. Director Bragg indicated the total cost for the part-time position would be \$35,000 per year including PERS and Medicare.

• Commissioner Christian-Bennett indicated the Board would discuss this and give them their decision.

B. Discussion:

1. Vison and Comprehensive Plan 2050

Director Peetz indicated the purpose of the Vision Plan would be to have a much more indepth discussion of the "big picture" for Portage County and would be used to guide the Comprehensive Plan. Both projects would be done simultaneously, and extensive community input for the Vision Plan while data gathering, map creation and community team building. The Vision Plan is optional, but a more thorough vision would greatly enhance and better define policy and goal setting decisions.

Commissioner Christian-Bennett indicated that the Comprehensive Plan needs to be continuously updated. We want to engage with other communities with their plan and collaborate.

Director Peetz indicated the cost for the Vision Plan would be \$18,631.00 and the Comprehensive Plan is \$100,857. Last year it was agreed to do the Comprehensive Plan for \$50,000 the difference would go against their debt for the RPC Office Building and Technical Assistance hours

If the Board of Commissioners wishes to do both the Vision Plan and Comprehensive Plan at a cost of \$68,631.00. Director Bragg indicated that this project was not included in the budget for 2021 but could be arranged. Commissioner Christian-Bennett said it is a good investment at this point. The Board of Commissioners agreed for Director Peetz to move forward with the Vision Plan and the Comprehensive Plan. Director Bragg indicated an agreement would have to be established and approved by the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Christian-Bennett asked Director Peetz to see if TA hours can be applied.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ed Dean, Township Trustee asked the Commissioners to decide as soon as they can regarding the recycling. There needs to be some type of recycling and the townships need to know for budget reasons. He understands a lot of issues need to be worked out. Commissioner Christian-Bennett realizes there are issues and there needs to be a solution and Director Steiner is working on it.
