The tax budgets will be placed on display Friday, June 22, 2018, advertised Thursday, June 21, 2018 and the public hearings will be July 12, 2018. The Board can still modify the budget up until July 12, 2018. Once the public hearings have been completed and the tax budgets approved, they will be presented to the Budget Commission, who will hold its own hearing and there are approximately 26-28 entities that have requested hearings to fight for the local government share.

Commissioner Kerrigan asked if Director Bragg was planning on using the negative balance at the end of the year to justify the \$3.35 million presented in the local government fund in receipts or if he was planning to advocate for additional funds on top of the \$3.35 million and Director Bragg responded he would like to stay even, but the goal would be to get back to an alternative formula. The Budget Commission has the sole discretion this year because the County did not turn in an alternative formula and the Budget Commission must make a decision around the 15th of August.

Commissioner Kline asked about the Commissioners' Other Expenses that show a decrease and Director Bragg will provide an update as to what caused the decrease.

Director Bragg asked what the Board would like prepared for the meeting Tuesday with Director Dillon. The meeting is a follow up to Commissioner Kerrigan's meeting with Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management Director Shackelford and Motor Pool Director Dillon, to talk about priorities for the Motor Pool.

The Board went on to discuss the needs of the Motor Pool and agreed it will need to have a conversation with outside fleet management to see what that entails, what is provided, and the cost of the service based on the fleet in the County. What the County is doing now is not sustainable. The Board also talked about reducing fleet once a vehicle reaches the end of its useful life.

On Thursday, Water Resources Director Roberts will be discussing County owned property in Streetsboro that is landlocked, but abuts City property in the area they would like to build their new facility. There are also several other County owned properties on Page, Tower and Pike, originally planned for a water tower, the Mayor would like to acquire, as well. Director Bragg pointed out the Solid Waste Management District is still struggling with the City of Streetsboro to get a recycling contract in place after one year in operation.

Next Tuesday, the Board will be talking about the  $6^{th}$  floor renovation and the need for paint, carpeting and new lighting. Cubicles could be placed in the common area to accommodate the Information Technology Department, and the floor could house Regional Planning Commission and Tax Map, as well.
