I can check the kiosk where I will find a map and park information such as upcoming events and educational programs.



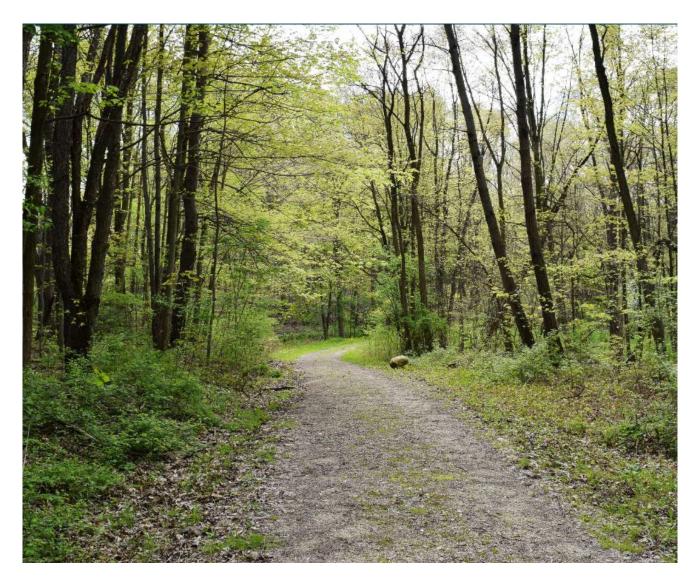
Before I hike, I may want comfortable walking shoes, water, insect repellent, or sunscreen depending on the weather.



There is a restroom near the parking lot. The toilet does not flush and there is not running water. I can use hand sanitizer to wash my hands.



A picnic table is located on the south side of the parking lot. I can rest here for a snack I brought from home or attend a park program.



The trails at Dix Park are natural surface: this means there may be mud, roots, or rocks where I am walking.



Along the trails are four brown markers with numbers and QR codes on them. I can use a smart phone to scan this code to participate in self-guided learning.



Benches on the sides of the trails make a great place to rest and listen to the sounds of nature.



Dix Park is a great place to see spring wildflowers. I can visit in all seasons if I dress for the weather.



I can use the map at the kiosk to choose a trail. The Farm Lane trail is an out and back trail, meaning I will walk back the way I came.
