COVID-19 Pop-Up Testing Sites Available in Northeast Ohio

Sites throughout Ohio located in underserved areas open to anyone

COLUMBUS – COVID-19 pop-up testing sites will be available in northeast Ohio in Alliance and Rootstown starting on July 21 and running through July 25. Anyone can get a no-cost test at these locations. No appointment is needed; anyone can walk-in on the scheduled day. A health care provider’s referral is not needed. Quantities may be limited.

Pop-up testing sites throughout Ohio are located in underserved areas but are open to anyone. The other regional locations will be announced soon. More information is available at coronavirus.ohio.gov.
