

JFS Benefits Available to Those Impacted by COVID-19



Families/Individuals who have lost employment due to the COVID-19 epidemic are eligible to apply for the following programs:

Families

Prevention, Retention, and Contingency (PRC)

Families who have lost employment as a result of Covid 19 are eligible to apply for a one time \$300 payment through the county's PRC Plan. Additional services also available through PRC include Employment Expenses, Family Support Services, Home Extermination, Home Repair, Housing Assistance and Utility Assistance. PRC eligibility requirements include being a us citizen or qualified alien, having minor child in the home and household income under 200% Federal Poverty Line.
